**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:** Several Water System upgrades have previously been completed and a couple more upgrades are slated to be completed in the near future. In an effort to continue the Village Water System upgrade, one of the next priorities is to construct the below grade two-hundred and fifty thousand (250,000) gallon water tank above the Kachina Village area. First and foremost, this tank and line system will provide the much needed fire suppression pressurization for Kachina Village area. It will also allow for water chlorination contact time and water storage for the Village of Taos Ski Valley entire Water System.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Staff recommends the approval of Resolution 2014-251 authorizing staff to apply for funding through the Water Trust Board.
