IV. NEW BUSINESS

A. PUBLIC HEARING: Consideration to approve the Liquor License Application #927093, Rio Hondo H&R Inc., dba, The Bavarian, for Issuance for New Restaurant Beer/Wine License

After introduction by Clerk Wooldridge, the Mayor opened the Public Hearing. Thomas Schultz spoke FOR the approval of the liquor license. He stated that this was not a transfer, but an application for a new beer and wine license due to the new TSV, Inc. ownership of The Bavarian. Schulze also stated that the Bavarian has had no incidents in the past 20 years. Cassandra Romero and Ricardo Valdez, representatives of the Rocky Mountain Youth Corps and Taos Alive, spoke AGAINST the approval of the liquor license. They stated that while they were not necessarily speaking against the approval, they wanted to inform the Council that they are working to diminish the number of liquor licenses in New Mexico. They talked about limiting outlets to no more than one license for every 2,000 population, excluding restaurant licenses (beer and wine only). The Council thanked them for their input. The Mayor closed the Public Hearing and asked if there was any further discussion from the Council.
